The Government of the Democratic Republic of Sao Tome and Principe (RSTP), through the Ministry of Planning and Finance, has received financing from the African Development Bank and the African Development Fund, toward the cost of the <u>Institutional Support Project for Customs Administration and Public Expenditure Management (ISP-CAPEM)</u>, and intends to apply part of the agreed amount for this Grant to payments under the contract with a **Project Procurement Specialist**.

The Services included under this project are, but not limited to: (i) design and establish the procurement function, including the staffing structure, functional allocations, linkages with other departments, training and mentoring, and design of procedures and development of manuals for procurement; (ii) carrying out procurement activities including, among other, the preparation and consolidation of the procurement plans, preparation of bidding documents and RFP's, facilitation of obtaining required necessary clearances, preparation of advertisements, responding to bidders' clarifications on advertised contracts and playing a central role in the evaluation of bids and proposals, and contract management roles.

The duration of the assignment is 36 months.

The ISP-CAPEM now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested individual consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (CV, cover letter, letters of reference, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, possession of appropriate skills etc).

The individual consultants must possess the following qualifications:

 Bachelor's degree in engineering, law, public administration, economics and documented previous experience in similar assignments. Master's degree in public procurement or Procurement Certification will be considered an advantage.
